Medical Transition Assistance is a program for new Kaiser Permanente members in California who are receiving ongoing care from a specialty provider for acute, chronic conditions and would like to transition into Kaiser Permanente for their services with minimal disruption of care.

- **Post-Op follow up care**
- **Psychiatric medications**
- **Neurological treatment**
- **Cardiology treatment**
